



## Pennsylvania Department of Health WIC Dietetic Internship

### Graduation and Program Completion Requirements

Graduation from the PA WIC DI program will occur as long as there is successful completion of the following:

- A minimum of 1250 supervised practice hours are completed and logged.
- All required documentation for each rotation has been submitted to preceptors and DI Program Director following each rotation.
- The Dietetic Intern has completed all required assignments/rotations satisfactorily as assessed by the preceptor and/or DI Program Director's grading process.
- The Dietetic Intern has no outstanding financials or negative circumstances pending with any rotation sites.
- The Dietetic Intern has demonstrated ethical and professional performance in accordance with the values of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics and has performed competencies as an entry-level practitioner through satisfactory completion of all scheduled supervised practice rotations with an overall grade of 3 or higher on all competencies.
- All required time logs, evaluation forms, self-assessments have been submitted by assigned due dates.

If an intern has not been able to complete the program within the required time frame, due to an authorized reason, the internship may be extended to a maximum of sixty-five (65) weeks.
